**GENERAL RULES:**

1. This contest is open to any amateur artist, crafter, quilter, etc., male or female, any age, and any county of residence.
2. Any professional artist, crafter, etc. may present entries for display only, not to be judged. A professional is defined as anyone who teaches their skill(s) and/or regularly profits from the sale of their artistry, craft and/or skills.
3. Exhibits shall have been made, completed or prepared by exhibitor and never before exhibited at Riley Festival.
4. No entry fee will be charged.
5. Exhibits will be judged in two categories: JUNIOR: 16 and under and SENIOR: 17 and above; except when there are less than 3 entries in a section, Junior entries could be judged with Seniors.
6. **ALL ENTRIES IN ALL CATEGORIES ARE DUE WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 30, 2020, 12 P.M. TO 6 P.M. at the COURT HOUSE ANNEX, 111 American Legion Plaza, Greenfield IN.**
7. **THE SHOW WILL CLOSE ON SUNDAY, OCTOBER 4, 2020 AT 4:00 P.M. EXHIBITS WILL BE RELEASED FROM 4:30 PM. – 5:30 PM. NO EARLY RELEASES!**
8. Each entry will be awarded a ribbon signifying a blue, red, white or participation ribbon, Grand Champion ribbons will be awarded in each category with an asterisk (\*) providing an entry merits the honor.
9. The Hancock County Extension Homemakers will use all diligence to assure the safety of articles after arrival and during the festival. They will in no case be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur.
10. We reserve the right to combine, add or separate sections, according to the number of entries received.
11. All entries for **Food Preservation MUST be labeled as to the content, date preserved and processing method.**
12. All entries in all **Food Preparation must include the recipe.**

14. Categories will be added or deleted at the Judges' discretion.

**NO paraffin allowed.** Entry must include **content, date preserved and processing procedure.**
